Generally an association for competition is expected to have a narrow focus on holding competitions. However, our stance is different in that our group came together with a sole mission to simply grow R/C drifting. And one part of this mission is to bring credible stature to drift competitions by introducing uniform technical rules and judging criteria, which we plan to showcase at our first ever Asia Championship.
